Bah Humbug! Lions Not In Party Mood

On come, all ye faithful (tick), joyful (hmm) and triumphant (afraid not) to the return fixture against Rhydyfelin.

Playing in unfamiliar blue and white and playing with the cold wind the game started as it was to go on. [Forgive me it is panto season] Oh no it wasn't. Well in that case how come within the first two minutes the order of play was set.

The opposition won the ball and after a series of mauls scored the opening try. Look out, I say, they're not here to have their tummy tickled so time to wake up.

On five minutes the awakening occurred. An excellent tackle, by Al Sams, stopped an attack and a charge down by Tommy Barclay bounced kindly. He regathered and sped fifty metres to bring the scores level.

The kick off was taken by Adam Nyhan (one of many good takes) and an attack set up. A chip through, by Josh James, and a hack forward brought play up to Rhydyfelin's line. Quick ball allowed Tommy to go over for his, and the team's, second try, the conversion, courtesy of Kieran, gave The Lions a seven point lead.

On ten minutes an offside gave a penalty over 40m out but Kieran slotted the kick. At this point things weren't exactly rosy – more a pale pink but a lead is a lead (unless it's a pencil, obviously). Unfair, I hear you say. Well remember dear reader I know the final score. Rhydyfelin then had possession from the kick off and only stout defence, courtesy of Elliott, Lee and Scott and others, kept them out. The attacks persisted, however, and ended only when they were held up over the line.

From the drop kick further attacks ensued and, from a scrum, twenty metres out, a pickup and pass saw the opposition score a try and convert. Too easy I'm afraid but also likely to happen when players haven't played together much. Multiple changes, for a variety of reasons, injuries foremost, doesn't help.

The next five minutes involved kicks, scrums and lineouts (the usual) but little penetration by either side. In the twenty fifth minute Llanishen were awarded a penalty which, Kieran kicked from forty-five metres.

The Lions gained the ball but a turnover gave Rhydyfelin the ball back and after strong running and mauling a try in the corner. The missed conversion meant Llanishen still led (no music available for 18-17).

A magnificent take, by Ewan, from the kick off was unfortunately wasted as a knock on brought the half to a close.

Playing into the cold wind was going to be hard but from the kick off a knock on gave an attacking platform. The opposition backs crept offside and Kieran kicked the penalty to extend the lead.

Rhydyfelin then scored a fine try, inter-passing and good support, to put the winger over in the corner. A well struck conversion put the visitors in front.

Llanishen looked to up their game and a number of good runs by Adam, Alex and Lewis gave attacking opportunities that weren't taken. In fairness the opposition's tackling and general defence was tenacious. They wanted the win.

Twenty minutes to go and a fine 50-22 by Tommy gave the supporters hope. Unfortunately, the attack came to nothing and worryingly the scrum was now coming under pressure.

With thirteen minutes to go the Lion's scrum coughed up possession and an easy try was scored. The conversion took the opposition ten points clear.

A second great take, by Ewan, gave Llanishen good field position and penalty was conceded. Kieran kicked the penalty and with five minutes left a possibility of a draw.

The boys tried and a good run, by George, set up a position for Hadyn to kick a 50-22. Unfortunately, the ball was lost and not long afterwards the ball was kicked to touch to bring the game to an end.

SPECTATORS CODE OF CONDUCT



- Spectators must uphold the values of both the Club / School and the WRU and at all times exhibit the highest standards of good behaviour.
- Spectators must not enter the field of play immediately before, during or immediately after a match.
- Spectators must not at any time throw objects onto the field of play.
- Spectators must not engage in or tolerate offensive, insulting or abusive language or behaviour, or physical abuse or behaviour towards the match officials, Players, coaches, team managers, officials and other spectators.
- Spectators must not engage in any behaviour that is likely to intimidate, offend, insult, humiliate or discriminate against any other Person on the grounds of age, disability, gender reassignment, race (including colour, nationality, ethnic or national origins), religion or belief, sex, sexual orientation.
- Spectators must not verbally or physically abuse Referees or other match officials before, during or after a match. The Referee's and other match officials' contribution to a contribution to a matches is vital. Without referees there can be no match.
- After a match, spectators must respect the Players and officials of both teams and must not under any circumstances approach them in anything other than a sporting and friendly manner.
- Spectators must not approach a referee or any other match official after the match to discuss the events of the match.


